## TITLE VI NOTICE OF PUBLIC PROTECTION

## Notice of Public Protection

The Montachusett Regional Planning Commission (MRPC) and the Montachusett Metropolitan Planning Organization (MMPO) fully comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and related statutes and regulations in all programs and activities. The MRPC and MMPO operate without regard to race, color, national origin, creed, income, gender, age, and disability. Any person who believes/him/herself or any specific class of persons, to be subjected to discrimination prohibited by Title VI may by him/herself or by representative file a written complaint with the MRPC or the MMPO. A complaint must be filed no later than 180 days after the date of the alleged discrimination.

Obligations and complaint procedures can be translated upon request to the MRPC or MMPO.
